Information sheet on admission to the Albertus Magnus student residence in Heidelberg

The Albertus-Magnus-Haus is a student residence run by the Roman Catholic parish of Heidelberg. In addition to being a good space to live and work, it offers students many opportunities to widen and deepen their own social, cultural and religious horizons. Students of all subjects, nationalities and religious denominations can apply for admission to the hall of residence.

A prerequisite for admission is willingness of the applicant to use their own skills to contribute to the house community and enrich communal life. Residents of the AMH are expected, of their own initiative, to shape life together and take responsibility within the framework of co-administration. Additionally, a basic personal attitude is expected of residents that corresponds to, and is accepting of, the Christian orientation of the AMH. This includes an interest in examining one's own faith and other religious beliefs and worldviews and a willingness to participate in the programme of the house and the offers of the Catholic University Centre. Formal prerequisite for admission is enrolment at **Universität Heidelberg, Pädagogische Hochschule Heidelberg, Hochschule für Kirchenmusik Heidelberg or Hochschule für Jüdische Studien Heidelberg.**

The house is in a quiet in in Heidelberg-Neuenheim. A total of 63 students live in 1-person rooms over four floors. There is also a separate flat in the basement, which is rented out as a shared flat.

All rooms are furnished (desk, bed, slatted frame (no mattress!), shelf, wardrobe) and have internet access. There is also a washbasin in most rooms - the exception to this are the rooms in the basement and in the shared flat. Shared toilets and showers are available on all floors. A kitchen with a shared lounge area is also available to residents on each floor. The following common rooms are also available for use by the house community: TV room, library, chapel, a bar and laundry room.

The language of daily business in the AMH is German. It therefore offers international students an excellent environment in which to learn German.

The tenancy agreement begins on 1 April or 1 October and ends on 31 March or 30 September. It is extended every semester upon request. The maximum period of residence is six semesters. Applicants are not entitled to specific rooms.

Applications for admission to the hall of residence must be submitted **via the online application form at the latest by 15 January or 15 June for the following semester:**

1. completed online form

compiled into one PDF (max. 5 MB):

2. letter of motivation (max. 1 page)

3. portrait photo (please include your name on the back)

4. Meaningful (from people who know you well!) references/letters of recommendation (social/church/political volunteering or work, social clubs, youth work...)

5. certificate of enrolment

6. proof of valid liability insurance

If no certificate of enrolment is available at the time of application, this can be submitted later. Please note this clearly in your application!

Only complete applications will be accepted.

Admission to the hall of residence is decided by a committee consisting of the management, members of the parish council of Heidelberg City Church, a representative of the KUZ and two representatives of the residents. The submitted applications are made available to the committee in full.
